In 2016, the Rotaract Club at UW Bothell's sponsor - Woodinville Rotary Club - and the Scholarship Foundation of Northshore, created the UW Bothell Rotarian of the Year Scholarship to be awarded a member of the Rotaract Club at UW Bothell to recognize outstanding leadership and service to school and community. This scholarship is offered and is designed to assist a student club member who is currently enrolled at the University of Washington Bothell.

Applicants must be in good academic standing (2.5 cumulative GPA or higher), and will be continuing studies at UW Bothell while remaining active with the UW Bothell Rotaract Club during the 2017 - 2018 academic year. Finalists for the scholarship will be selected by an interview team comprised of leaders of Woodinville Rotary, the Scholarship Foundation and Rotaract alumni. Financial need will be given consideration as a holistic part of the application; as not to exclude students of a particular financial background.

Scholarship Use:

The scholarship may be used only for tuition and fees and must be used within the described academic year. A written request to use the scholarship at a later starting time may be submitted for Foundation consideration.

Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
